## ICES VME Data Use Arrangements

Access and use conditions for ICES Vulnerable Marine Ecosystems (VME) data portal

February 2016



Within the VME dataset, available at <a href="http://vme.ices.dk">http://vme.ices.dk</a>, data are classified as either **public** or **restricted**. Public data follow the ICES Data policy, restricted data may be available on request according to the procedure described below.

## Public Data

- 1. Correct and appropriate data interpretation is solely the responsibility of data users.
- 2. Data Users must not expressly or otherwise imply ICES substantiation of their work, results, conclusions and/or recommendations.
- 3. Data sources must be duly acknowledged.
- 4. Data Users must respect any and all restrictions on the use or reproduction of data, such as restrictions on use for commercial purposes.
- 5. Data Users are obliged to inform ICES of any suspected problems in the data.
- 6. Data Users are encouraged to inform ICES of possible sources of other relevant data.

## Restricted Data

- 2. Where available, the Responsible Organisation and Point of Contact is provided for each record, to enable the Data User to make a request direct to the Point of Contact.
