RESEARCH FOCUS



- WGBIE carries out stock assessments for 24 commercial fish stocks distributed over a large area of the Northeast Atlantic shelf - from ICES Division 3a to 4a.
- WGBIE currently comprises 35 fishery scientists from 6 countries (France, Ireland, Norway, Portugal, Spain, and the UK)
- WGBIE is committed to improving the quality of science in support of ICES advice.

OUR OBJECTIVE

- Our objective is to provide the technical basis for the advice based on the most adequate, sound, and scientifically validated stock assessment methods.

- We are good at assessing the number of fish hidden beneath the surface of the sea. To do this well, we need to know a few things:
 - Stock identification methods
 - Spatial analysis (UWTV, INLA, etc)
 - Life-history
 - Fleet behavior

 - Surplus-production models
 - Age-structured models
 - Length-structured models
 - Integrated assessment models
 - Management strategy evaluation
