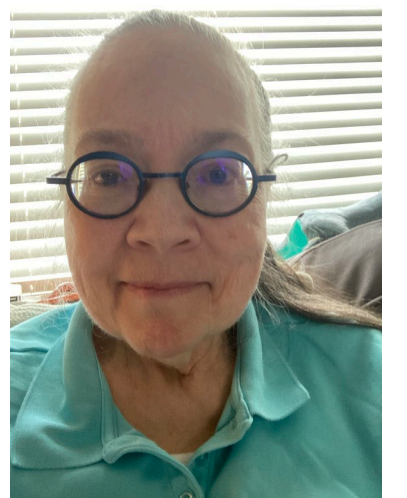
OUR EXPERTISE
