

Ecosystem Observation Steering Group (EOSG)

RESEARCH FOCUS

- Developing standardized protocols for a coordinated bottom trawl survey of eastern Georges Bank and the Gulf of Maine.
- Creation of standardized trawl survey strata of the area of interest.
- Establishing data management processes to store a combined fisheries dataset accessible by both countries.
- Developing an inventory of oceanographic data collected by both countries that would support integrated ecosystem assessments across the area of interest.


OUR OBJECTIVE

WGNAEO is focused on coordinating fishery-independent trawl survey activities between Canada and the United States, enhancing data sharing, and analyses to inform integrated ecosystem science across the Northwest Atlantic.
