Statistical Department,

Bulletin Statistique for 1953 (Vol. XXXVIII) was issued and distributed in September.

In June the "normal" forms and a special one for information concerning. "catch per unit of effort" were sent to the member countries and most of the material for 1954 is now to hand and the manuscript is being prepared for printing.

In September all the material received regarding "catch per unit of effort" were duplicated and sent to Mr. R. G. R. Wall, President of the Permanent Commission, for distribution to the members of the Permanent Commission.

Hydrographical Department.

Bulletin Hydrographique. The 1951 volume was prepared and published. It has not been possible to go further as many data from 1952 have been received only recently, and a few are still lacking.

Hydrographical Card Index. All data received for incorporation in the Bulletin Hydrographique have been recorded on index cards together with some data from other sources. Copies of card index data have been supplied on request. An estimate (partly based on counting) of the number of surface observations in the card index has been undertaken at the request of the Sub-Committee on Mean Charts.

Wind-Nata, received from the German Hydrographic Institute, have been copied and distributed regularly.

Synoptic Hydrographic Charts, During the year under consideration charts for the months July 1954 - May 1955 have been prepared and published. The Provisional Mean Charts, compiled by Lt.-Commander J. R. Lumby, have been published and distributed.

Notes on the variation of surface water temperature. Monthly anomalies during 1954 of the surface water temperature in a number of areas, and at one station, in the norhtern North Atlantic, as well as in one area off the eastern coast of Scotland, have been calculated and submitted to the Annales Biologiques.
