<u>Distribution of Information on Unattended</u> Oceanographic Buoys

At the ICES Statutory Meeting in 1962 the following Resolution was passed by the Council (C.Res.1962/10; 9b):-

- (i) that the standard distinctive marking proposed by the IOC for oceanic buoys, when these have been agreed internationally should be used by all members of the ICES
- (ii) that efforts be made by all ICES members, by means of posters, hand-outs, magazine articles, etc. to give the maximum publicity among shipping agencies, especially among fishermen, of the increasing use of oceanographic buoys
- (iii) that each member of ICES should nominate a national office to be responsible for the rapid distribution of details of programmes involving the use of oceanographic buoys, and should forward the name and address of this office to the General Secretary thereafter to prepare a list of these national offices for distribution among members
 - (iv) that ICES members should investigate the possibility of using national radio networks to broadcast warning about oceanographic buoys, reporting the results of this investigation at the next Council Meeting.

In accordance with this Resolution a list of national offices was set up. An updated version is given as Appendix I.

At the Statutory Meeting in 1967 the Service Hydrographique was asked to collect information as to

- a) how long notice the various offices require in order to assure in due time a sufficiently wide distribution of the information:
- b) what could be done to assist the offices in making the distribution of information more effective; would it, e.g., be of any help if they were furnished with posters in various languages?

The information received in reply to a circular letter to the national offices is recorded in Appendix II.
