

Test of a remote terminal connection to the ICES Computer

During its meeting in 1980 the ADP Working Group recommended that the ICES Systems Analyst in collaboration with Mr. K. Laumann should investigate the possibility of a connection between the ICES computer and a remote terminal. To try out such a connection, in cooperation with a hardware engineer of Norsk Data, one of our existing terminal interfaces was connected to a modem with an automatic answering facility. The communication characteristics were set at 300 baud, full duplex, asynchronous.

Two tests were then made: one by a portable terminal with an acoustic coupler from a telephone installed in the ICES Secretariat, and another by a terminal and a telephone installed in the Danish Institute for Fishery and Marine Research. Both tests turned out to be successful.

It can thus be stated that the ICES computer could be used with a remote terminal if the necessary equipment permitting such a connection were installed. However, it should be noted that at present the Secretariat has no intention of installing such equipment, since there is no evidence available that sufficient interest does exist in remote connections to justify the expenditure. The expenditure will amount to a one time payment of ca. Dkr. 18000,- and annual fees of ca. Dkr. 44 00,-.
