Provisional Programme of Work for
Service Hydrographique 1971/72

1. Edit and/or publish

- a) "Report on Oceanographic Cruises and Data Stations", the issues for 1970 and 1971.
- b) "Inventory of Oceanographic Investigations at North Atlantic Ocean Weather Stations", the volumes for 1969, 1970 and 1971, and possibly some back issues (1966 and earlier).
- c) Data collected at OWS "India" 1964-1966, with an analysis of the data. (In collaboration with Fisheries Laboratory, Lowestoft.)
- d) Lists of data collected during the International Baltic Year 1969/70.
- e) Inventories of oceanographic data deriving from CINECA expeditions.
- f) Inventory of all existing oceanographic data from the CINECA region.
- g) List of Ocean Data Stations in the ICES area, as requested by IOC.
- h) A number of the outstanding Data List volumes for the period 1957-1962.

2. Preparation of monthly charts of

- a) Temperature and salinity at bottom and surface for the region covered by the ICES North Sea Young Herring Survey 1972 — the months January-March, together with anomaly charts.
- b) Temperature and salinity at 10 m depth and near bottom in Skagerrak + Kattegat.
- c) Bottom temperature and salinity in the North Sea.

3. Calculation and/or publication of mean values and anomalies

- a) Monthly means of sea surface temperature and salinity in regions (1°Lat. x 2°Long.) of the north-eastern North Atlantic in 1968 and 1969.
- b) Monthly anomalies of sea surface temperature in standard areas of the northern North Atlantic in 1970.
- c) Monthly anomalies as under b) for the period 1876-1968.

4. Other data centre functions.

- a) Screening of data.
- b) Punching and veripunching of data
- c) Supply of data copies to the WDC system
- d) Retrieval and supply of data on request.

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
