Help plan the future of ICES – what do you want your organisation to be?

As ICES initiates a process to revise and update its strategic plan, it is important to make sure that the ICES community is afforded every opportunity to participate and contribute. - 2. Cooperation and a strategy/framework
- 3. Doing things more efficient (e.g. databases)
